Day 01 Brunei / Singapore – Beijing (SQ 810 1655-2310)

Assemble at Brunei International Airport for your flight to Beijing via Singapore. Upon arrival in Beijing airport, meet and transfer to hotel for check-in.

Hotel: Holiday Inn Express Beijing Temple Of Heaven 3*

Day 02 Beijing – Harbin by flight (CN7129 0940-1120)

After breakfast, you will be transferred to airport for flight to Harbin. Your Harbin tour begins with visiting to **Flood Control Monument**, built to commemorate the several floods of Songhua River. It is the centerpiece of the popular Stalin Park, built in 1958 to commemorate the tremendous feat of the Harbin people in controlling the massive flood of 1957. After that, continues to visit Stalin Park. Then, you will walk along the **Central Street**. There are buildings of most European early twentieth-century styles along the length of this cobbled street, which remains today the most popular shopping area of the city. Before dinner, you will go to **China-Russia Trade Market**, there you can pick up some knick-knacks as gift for your friends, such as Telescope, Russian items.

Special dinner: Feilong Banquet.

Day 03 Harbin – Changchun by private vehicle (B/L/SD)

After breakfast, you will take a visit to **Siberian Tiger Park**. 15km further north than Sun Island Park, Here you can find about three hundred Siberian tigers, lions and other big cats. There are only an Estimated 700 Siberian tigers left in the wild, so Harbin's park is an important breeding base. After the park, to the east of the Central Street, surrounded on all sides by modern department stores, you will find the **Church Of St.Sophia**, a lovely Orthodox church that is Harbin's most famous landmark. It was badly damaged during the Cultural Revolution but later restored to its original 1907 splendor. Then, you will pay a visit to **Sun Island park**, which was once the retreat of choice for Harbin residents in the hot summer. A huge park with plenty of green to counteract the gray palette of the city's apartment blocks, it's pleasant to stroll around when sunny, though it really comes into its own when snow falls and the yearly sculpture exhibition moves in. In the afternoon, drive to Changchun. **Special Dinner:** Changchun Herbal Cuisine

Day 04 Changchun – Jilin by private vehicle (B/L/SD)

After breakfast, visit to **Puppet Manchu Palace Museum**. It is a royal palace site museum located in northeast corner of Changchun, northeast China. Puyi, the Last Emperor of Qing Dynasty's China, was living here during the Japanese occupation of northeast China in 1930s. Before lunch, you will take a walk along **Changchun Cultural Square**, which evolved from the Dizhigong Square, is the largest open area in Changchun City. In the afternoon, drive you to Jilin city. You will take a visit to **Beishan Park**, situated in the southwest of the city, consists mainly of hills rising to a height of some 200m/650ft. In the eastern part are the Temple of the War God and the Pavilion of the Jade Emperor. Then, take a visit to **Meteorite Museum**. In March 1976 a heavy meteorite shower hit the area around Jilin. **Special Dinner:** The three sets of bowl banquet

Day 05 Jilin – Shenyang by private vehicle (B/L/SD)

After breakfast, drive to visit Zhang Xue Liang's Mansion, who is one of modern China's most honored figures. He is something of a folk hero in Northeastern China. Born into a powerful warlord family at the end of the Qing Dynasty, Zhang grew to become the leader of the Northeastern China government, army general, founder of Northeastern University, and commander of the resistance against Japan. This mansion turned museum was Zhang Xue Liang's home and office, as well as the headquarters of the city government before the Japanese invasion. Then, pay a visit to **Shenyang Imperial Palace**, located at No. 171, Shenyang Road, Shenhe District in Shenyang City, is the only existing royal palace in China outside of the Forbidden City in Beijing. The main structure of the palace was built in 1625 when Nurhachi was in power. It was finished in 1636 by his son Abahai. Nurhachi and Abahai were both founding emperors of the Qing Dynasty. Covering an area of more than 60,000 square meters, the Shenyang Imperial Palace is one twelfth the size of the Forbidden City in Beijing. The palace consists of more than 300 rooms, formed around 20 courtyards. After lunch, walk along **Manchu and Qing Dynasty street** for shopping. Then, transfer you to **Zhong walking street** for free shopping too.

Special Dinner: Shenyang Master Bian's Dumpling

Hotel: Shenyang Dongxu Business Hotel 3* or similar

Day 06 Shenyang – Beijing – Singapore CZ 6105 1530-1705 / SQ 801 0015-0630 (B/SL)

After breakfast, transfer to **North Tomb of Shenyang**, also called Zhaoling Tomb, enjoys equal fame with Fu Tomb and Yong Tomb. All these tombs are jointly called three imperial tombs outside Shanhaiguan. However, Zhaoling Tomb is much beyond the other two in terms of scale and layout. It is the largest park in Shenyang City, covering an area of 330 hectares. It is spacious and bright with splendor pavilions and palaces. The yellow tiles, red walls and green trees set each other off. After lunch, transfer to airport for flight to Beijing and connecting flight back to Brunei via Singapore.

Special Lunch: Diaolubing Toasted duck
